<b>Old Business</b>	<b>Christmas on Main</b>	Members gave a report on the Christmas on Main sponsorship and discussed possible sponsorship for the 2020 event as well.
<b>New Business</b>	<b>Legislative Update</b>	The new Federal law about age 21 for purchase of nicotine products was discussed as well as bills that are in the Florida Legislature.
	<b>SWAT update</b>	Kick Butts Day is now called the National Day of Action. SWAT clubs are participating in this activity following the Spring Break/Fair break.
	<b>Through With Chew Week</b>	Through With Chew Week was held the previous week. The dental practices participated in this observance by educating patients and the parents of youth patients about the health issues associated with smokeless tobacco use. They also provided Quit Your Way information. Additionally, the Gilchrist Library put up a display of information about the dangers of smokeless tobacco as well as ways to access Quit Your Way. This information was seen by hundreds of community members.
	<b>Action Plans</b>	Members worked on action planning to choose a topic or problem in the community related to tobacco or nicotine products, discuss what success in that area would look like to the group, and then work on setting goals while deciding what each member's responsibility would be.  The group chose to work on emerging products as an issue. This includes ENDS products, and also new nicotine containing products (such as nicotine toothpicks). Members agreed to put together a coordinated social media message campaign on personal social media pages, to work with the Prevention Coalition on their grant area related to retailers, and possibly use paid advertising and youth-driven campaigns.  The group will continue working on this plan during the next meeting.
